Motion from Kings Barton Resident's Association regarding the development of Sir John Moore barracks if Andover Road is closed – Two members of the public attended to express their concerns with the proposed development of Sir John Moore Barracks. They noted their concerns including the additional noise, increase in carbon emissions and the all-round impact on the residents. They requested that the Parish Council support their motion that this development should not go ahead if Andover Road is closed.
